
Subject:- General Elections to Legislative Assembly of Karnataka, 2018 – Re-Poll – regarding.

I am directed to state that on the basis of reports submitted, and after taking all material circumstances into account, the Commission hereby declares under Sub-Section (2) of Section 58 of the Representation of the People Act, 1951 that the poll taken on 12.05.2018 at polling station No.2-Gandhi Vidyalaya, Kannada and Tamil Primary School, Lettegollahalli of 158-Hebbal Assembly Constituency to be void and appoints the 14th May, 2018 (Monday) as the date and fixes the hours from 7.00 A.M. to 6.00 P.M. for taking a fresh poll at the said polling station in accordance with the Commission's instructions contained in Chapter XIII of Hand Book for Returning Officers.

2. Please ensure that wide publicity is given by beat of drums in the polling areas of that polling station. Inform the political parties and contesting candidates in writing about the fresh poll being taken on the said date.
3. Kindly inform all the Observers concerned under intimation to the Commission.
4. Kindly acknowledge and confirm action taken.

Counting Centres Details

1. For 222 Assembly Constituencies counting will be held in 38 Counting Centers.
2. Every district has one counting centre except in case of Chitradurga (2, same premise), Dakshin Kannada (2, same premise), Mysuru (2, 4.5KM away) and Tumkuru (3, same premise) where in counting is held in more than one location.
3. Maximum 14 tables per constituency are allowed to count the polled votes.
4. One table is manned by one counting supervisor, one counting assistant and one Micro-Observer
5. In case of Bangalore Rural(20 tables), Bangalore South(24 tables), Chikkaballapur(20 tables) and Kolar(3 counting halls) districts an additional counting hall and more than 14 tables are allowed due to large number of polling stations and contesting candidates.
6. Around 3100 tables are in place to count the votes and $9300(\text{required}) + 1860(\text{reserve}) = 11160(\text{total})$ counting staff have been appointed.
7. Total media passes issued are - *4000*
