All the polling stations are on the ground floor. The issue of providing Assured Minimum Facilities at all the Polling Stations has been taken up with the Chief Secretary. The State Government has been directed to complete the remaining AMF facilities at the earliest specially to facilitate PWD voters.

EVM and Voter Verifiable Paper Audit Trail (VVPAT):

1. **EVM with VVPATs** will be used in all the **58546** polling stations of **224** Assembly Constituencies of state. VVPAT provides for a transparent window through which a voter can see the name of the candidate, the symbol of the candidate and his serial number on a paper slip to whom he has cast his vote. The VVPAT paper slip remains visible for 7 seconds to allow the voter to verify that his vote has been cast as per his choice.
2. In order to enhance the transparency and credibility of the voting process, the Commission has directed that one polling station of each Assembly Constituency shall be randomly selected and VVPAT slips of this randomly selected Polling station shall be counted and matched with its EVM results.
3. As per the Commission's directions, comprehensive awareness about the use of VVPATs is being carried out by the State level, as well as by the district election machineries to familiarize and educate the electors, political parties and other crucial stakeholders about the multiple benefits of VVPAT usage for enhanced voter confidence through greater transparency in the election process

MARK-3 EVM

M-3 machines will be used on a pilot basis in the assembly seats of Rajarajeshwarinagar, Shivajinagar, Shanthinagar, Gandhinagar, Rajajinagar,

Chickpet and Chamarajpet. The election commission will be using 2700 ballot units, 2250 control units and 2350 VV PATS for the purpose. In all 1800 polling stations will see voters, exercise their franchise through M-3 machines.

LAW AND ORDER: SECURITY MANAGEMENT

1. State administration and police have been asked to take steps to tone up the security and law and order environment and preventive steps should be taken.
2. General, Police and Expenditure observers has be deployed in the state to monitor all activities and advise the administration to take suitable action. The contact numbers of these observers has been made available to public.
3. The CAPF has be used for Confidence Building Measures (CBMs). The CAPF vehicles have proper signage and public address system.
4. The Commission has directed the State government to make arrangements for providing cashless treatment facility to all polling staff, CAPF and police force deployed for election duty.
5. The Commission has also directed for making provision for Air Ambulances for quick evacuation in case of any exigencies.
6. Police have been directed to identify and take action against all identified trouble-mongers/anti-social elements/bad characters so as to not allow anyone to vitiate the election process.
7. Commission has directed that all police check posts across the state be kept under webcasting/ videography 24x7 for the entire period during the Election.
8. All licensed arms in the state to be verified and except those exempted by the District-level Committee, all others shall be deposited with the concerned Police Stations. Administration has been directed to launch a special drive for deposition of licensed arms.

EXPENDITURE MONITORING

1. Commission reviewed with enforcement agencies to curb misuse of money/drugs/liquor & gifts distribution. All DEOs has been Constitute Election Expenditure Monitoring Teams as per ECI Instructions.
2. 136 Expenditure observers has been deployed by ECI for effective expenditure monitoring.

3. Income Tax officials also have been deployed for expenditure monitoring.
4. **1344** Flying Squads (@ 6 per Assembly Constituency) and **1255** Static Surveillance Teams has been operationalized to check movement of cash liquor, drugs and other freebies during election process
5. The vehicles used by flying squads has been fitted with GPS to track their movement and prompt action.
6. Movement of money through banking channels has been monitored and fool-proof arrangements has been made to monitor suspicious banking transactions.
7. **Toll free number 18004252115** has been installed by Income Tax Department which is operational 24X7 along with two **mobile numbers 8277422825 and 8277413614** and **Land line number 080-22861126** and **fax number 080-22866916**. Email has also been created for complaints **cleankarnatakelection@incometax.gov.in**
8. Air intelligence Units of IT authorities set up at five Airports (Bengaluru, Belagavi, Mangalore, Hubli and Bellari)
9. Movement of cash through cash has been monitored by Railway Protection Force which would be deployed at all major railway stations.
10. Commission directed that affidavits of the candidates be uploaded on website within 24 hours of filing of nominations.
11. Commission directed the excise department to gear up and create stringent mechanism to prevent liquor distribution.
12. 200 mobile squads of Commercial Tax department has been work to monitor any attempt of distribution of freebies.

MCMC AND PAID NEWS

- MCMC (Media Certification and Monitoring Committee) committees are functional at every district, while state level committee is located at state capital. To facilitate the candidates living at faraway places from district headquarters, Commission has directed that pre-certification requests for electronic media advertisements can be received at RO level. RO has forward these requests to MCMC committee at district level. After certified advertisement received from MCMC committee, RO has deliver the certificate to the candidate in a time bound manner.
- MCMC committees has monitoring the possible cases of paid news from the date of Nominations.
- Commission has directed that all news television/news channels/newspapers including those owned by political parties/candidates be monitored.

INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY INITIATIVES:

The Commission has been successfully utilizing Information Technology based applications during elections, not only for improved facilitation of the various stakeholders like electors, election managers, political parties and candidates, but also to ensure efficient and effective monitoring of various election processes and redressal of public grievances.

New IT Applications for Karnataka Elections:

(a) SAMADHAN: Public Grievance Redressal and Monitoring System

A comprehensive, robust and reliable Public Grievance Redress System has been developed by the Election Commission to provide a common platform for all complaints, grievances, concerns and suggestions lodged by any member of the public, including our various stakeholders like political parties, candidates, civil society groups etc. A citizen has the multi-modal facility to lodge any election-related complaint via bouquet of channels/sources like Website, Email, letter, fax, SMS, Call-Centre (Call-center Number is “1950”) etc. A Mobile App is also being made available to the people, so that they can submit complaints with photographs/videos on the common platform.

(b) SUVIDHA: Single Window Permission System

A single window system for giving election-related permissions/clearances within 24 hours has been created. In this system, Candidates and Political Parties can apply for permissions for Meetings, Rallies, vehicles, temporary election office, loudspeakers etc at a single location, where back-end convergence of various authorities/departments has been done. This system has been put in place at every RO level in each sub-division, which has provide for applying, processing, granting and monitoring permissions in a synergistic manner. However, in case of permissions for Helicopter usage/landing and use of helipads, the application shall have to be submitted at least 36 hours in advance.

(c) SUGAM: Vehicle Management System:

It is an IT-based Vehicle Management System with the facility of issuance of requisition letters for vehicles, capturing of vehicle details with address, mobile number and bank details of owner and driver, transfer of vehicles from one district to another district etc., which has be used by election officials.

(d) ELECTION- ATLAS:

e-Atlas (GIS-Maps) has been prepared for 224-Assembly Constituencies of the State. GIS maps contains P.C. layers, AC layers, Polling Stations layers with information of DEOs, ROs, BLOs & AMF, Vulnerable & Critical Polling Stations etc.

(e) Webcasting:

To ensure free and fair elections, web-casting has be done in all the critical Polling Stations (in about 6000 polling stations), Counting Centers and Police Check Posts where internet connection is feasible and videography by fixed cameras in the rest.

(f) MCC reporting App

This App enables participation of all stakeholders in reporting MCC cases to election to election officer. The App enables capture of Audio, Video and photo of MCC violation and automatically send the complaint the election officer concerned through email. This app also authenticates the location of the incident.

Voter Facilitation

1. Commission has directed that all the necessary arrangements for facilitation and convenience of voters at the polling stations shall be made to ensure a smooth and comfortable voting experience. A voter facilitation App is being developed for Wheel Chair booking for the physically disabled.
2. **SMS Based Polling Station Access:** Accessing the information about the polling stations through SMS facility is provided to the citizens.
3. **App Based Polling Station and AMF access and navigation :** An app-based polling station navigation is being developed for the benefit of voters.
4. **Wheel Chair Booking for PwDs and Senior Citizens:** A mobile App and a web based module is being developed for online booking of facilities for the PWD voters.
5. **Queue Status Facility on Poll Day**
An app-based queue monitoring and information system has be put in place as a pilot in some of the urban polling stations where the data connectivity is feasible.

All Women Managed Polling Stations (SAKHI) :

1. For the first time in Karnataka, one all Women Managed Polling Station (Sakhi) has be set up in all Rural Assembly Constituencies and five in each urban Constituency (totalling 600 polling stations).
2. Revised Photo Voter slips, voter guide, voter facilitation posters have been provided. Height of voting compartment has been increased from 24 Inch 30 Inch.

ACCESSIBLE ELECTIONS:

1. The Commission has laid special emphasis on making the election process accessible for all sections of the electorate, especially the Persons with Disabilities (PwDs), aged and infirm electors etc. Towards this objective all polling premises has be provided with sturdy Ramps (temporary or permanent) for barrier free access. PWD employees are encouraged to participate in the polling process.

2. A data base of PwD voters is created and such electors are enrolled and mapped with PS and the list of the same shall be provided to the BLOs for providing special assistance.
3. Special facilities to PwD voters like wheel chair to the extent possible, waiting area, queue assistance, ramps, escort are being provided.
4. Braille dummy ballot paper for easy readability by the visually impaired voters would be provided.
5. Certain polling stations in tribal pockets are being established with ethnic look.
6. Special drive to enroll the left out primitive tribe and nomadic population has been undertaken.

SVEEP:

Commission has directed to organize a participative, inclusive and people-friendly SVEEP campaign through all modes of communication for ensuring ethical and informed voting.

Regular Media Interaction

1. The Commission considers media as its formidable ally and a force-multiplier in ensuring efficient election management and effective compliance of all laws, instructions and guidelines of the Commission.
2. CEO and DEOs has been meeting media regularly for intraction.
3. CEO office has a strong presence on social media platforms and has been promoting systematic voter education and electoral process.
4. Workshops for media to create awareness about MCC, MCMC and VVPAT & EVM have been conducted in all districts.

Finally

- **Commission is committed to maintain purity of elections and to deliver free, fair and transparent elections.**
- **Commission has directed the State level and District level Election Machinery to be fearless, unbiased, neutral and independent from any influence whatsoever. Anyone found left wanting on these standards, Commission has not hesitate to take stern action.**

Appeal :-

- Keeping in line with rich traditions of Karnataka, Commission appeals to all- Media, civil society groups, political parties, and public at large, to expose anything wrong happening, which may adversely affect the conduct of free and fair poll, so that immediate corrective action is taken by Commission. But at the same time help build global brand image for Indian Elections being free, fair, peaceful and most efficient in all aspects including declaration of results.

Participation (SVEEP)
reaches 5 crore people

SVEEP activities all over the state has reached 5,00,13,172 people all over the state till date.

Systematic Voters' Education and Electoral Participation (SVEEP) is a programme of multi interventions through different modes and media designed to educate citizens, electors and voters about the electoral process in order to increase their awareness and participation in the electoral processes. SVEEP is designed according to the socio-economic, cultural and demographic profile of the state as well as history of electoral participation in previous rounds of elections and learning thereof.

The Election Commission of India had commissioned Institute for Social and Economic Change to conduct a Baseline Survey to assess the Knowledge, Attitude and Practices(KAP) survey. SVEEP action plan was made to address the findings of the survey and the subsequent suggestions.

In all 5849 activities and events were conducted all over the state to create awareness about the electoral process. Over 2.50 Crore people have been reached through print media.

Around 1566 advertisements have been given in various newspapers, 348 televisions spots and 8,00,044 (seconds) Radio jingle have been released. 2,530 hoardings have been put up and 51,87,067 posters and handbills have distributed.

In addition, non-conventional media forms have also been used to educate people about the electoral process. 1,658 street plays and folk art forms have been demonstrated, 1, 549 rallies and Runs and 277 special events with district ICONs have been conducted. 7369 Special camps, 17,166 community engagements and 3156 other events have been done.

Social media has played a major role in SVEEP and 4,01,199 insertions have been made on various social media platforms.

Model Code of Conduct

Based on the information gathered from District Election Officers and Superintendent of Police, the following information on Model Code of Conduct violation and Law & Order enforcement is provided:

Model Code of Conduct:

As on date there are 1540 Flying Squads and 2131 Static Surveillance Teams have been activated. Flying Squads and other Model Code of Conduct Teams constituted for the purpose of enforcement on Model Code of Conduct have cumulatively removed **12537** number of Wall Writing, **17693** numbers of posters and **7711** number of banners from public property and have lodged **06** Cases under Karnataka Open Places (Provisions of disfigurement) act 1981. From Private Property cumulatively **6866** number of Wall Writing, **7949** number of posters and **2543** number of banners were removed.

Further, Static Surveillance Teams have seized Cash worth Rs. 24,35,500/-, 3 Vehicles worth Rs. 6,00,000/-, 178 Silver articles in last 24 hours. Cumulatively, the Static Surveillance Teams have seized **Rs.43,86,97,919/-** cash, Gold 49 Kg 552 Grams worth **Rs. 15,26,80,000/-**, Silver worth **Rs. 15,97,200/- & 178 Articles** , 268 Copper pots (Weight – 600 KG) worth **Rs. 3,24,000/-**, 267.49 litres of Liquor and vehicles & other items worth **Rs. 2,38,60,447/-**.

Further, Flying Squads Teams have seized Rs. 1,03,72,120/- Cash, 1 KG Silver, 18 Vehicles worth Rs. 20,94,170/-, 82.26 Litres worth Rs. 22,799/- and other Items: 47 Sarees worth Rs. 4,700/-, 2 Mobile worth Rs. 400/-, Party flags worth Rs. 6,630/-, Cooking items worth Rs. 30,000/- and party pamphlets worth Rs. 2,500/- in last 24 hours. Cumulatively, the Flying Squads Teams have seized **Rs.12,07,47,084/-** Cash, **1036.977** litres of liquor **8640** Whiskey Bottles, Gold worth **Rs. 4,10,98,000/-**, 13.165 KGs of Silver worth **Rs.2,40,000/-**, other items worth **Rs.14,92,06,675/-**, **237** vehicles worth **Rs.3,86,21,340/-**. Other Police authorities have seized cash worth Rs. 10,000/-, 433.60 Litres of liquor worth Rs. 1,41,543/- and 1 Vehicle in last 24 hours. Cumulatively, other police authorities have seized cash worth Rs. 42,45,000/-, **44.755 KG Gold worth Rs. 16,99,58,047/-**, DBBL Gun No. 18126 & 5 Cartridges, 135 Sarees, 160

Laptops,1199.773 Litres of Liquor, 10 Vehicles and Other items worth Rs. 2,60,930/-.

Cumulatively, Flying Squads, SSTs and other police authorities have seized Cash worth **Rs. 56,36,90,003/-**.

Flying Squad Teams & other Police authorities have booked FIRs in Cases 53 of Cash/other items related to seizure and other MCC related violations in the last 24 hours. Cumulatively, Flying Squads they have registered FIRs in **1124** Cases. SSTs they have registered **7** FIRs in cases of Cash/other items related to seizure in last 24 hours. Cumulatively, Static Surveillance Teams have registered FIRs in **165** Cases.

While Excise department have seized **1132.35** litres of IML & other liquor worth Rs. **6,52,758.15** and booked 52 Heinous cases, 44 cases for Breach of Licence conditions and 282 cases under Section 15 (a) of Karnataka Excise act 1965 in last 24 hours. Cumulatively, 71574 arms have been got deposited since the date of enforcement of Model Code of Conduct and out of total 97,043 arms 97,031 arms have been deposited till date, 52 arms were impounded, 6 armed licenses have been cancelled, preventive sections of CRPC are booked in **18096** cases since the date of enforcement of MCC and total 49,574 preventive section under CRPC cases have been put up from 01.01.2018 till date, **24831** persons were bounded over under preventive sections of CRPC and **40005** Non-bailable warrants were executed from the date of enforcement of elections.

Welfare measures For Election Staff

The Election Commission has taken up several measures to ensure the safety of election staff. The following are the measures prescribed by the Election Commission for the welfare of the staff:

- **Nodal Officer to monitor Welfare measures of election staff**

The District Election Officer has been appointed a nodal officer to plan and implement the welfare measures of the election staff. A review meeting has been held to discuss about the precautionary measures to be taken relating to the safety of the staff on election duty. Training on legal and statutory measures have been given to the District Nodal Officers.

- **Training**

The election staff is provided prior information relating to the place, date and time of the training programme. Their contact phone/mobile numbers is collected to forward bulk messages regarding the training programme.

- **Arrangements at training and dispatch centres**

Special attention has been given to identify suitable place to establish the training and dispatch centre, provide drinking water facility and help desk. These centres are equipped with necessary furniture and basic infrastructure along with rooms. Arrangements are made to provide food facility to the election staff as per Election Commission's guidelines. They were provided end to end transport facility to reach the booths in time.

Establishment of postal ballot paper distribution and receiving centre

The Election Commission of India has given utmost importance to safeguard the voting rights of the election staff. Accordingly a centre to receive the postal ballots of polling booth officers has been established. Details like Photo ID card, Sl. No., etc., of the election staff were collected well before time. Opportunity has been given to all the eligible election staff to exercise their franchise.

- **Relief provided in case of injury to the election staff while on duty :**

Recommendations of the ECI to State Governments

1. The compensation provided in case of death/injury to the officers on election duty will be as per the orders issued by the Election Commission of India vide its letter No:

ECI /218/6/2014/EPS, dated:25.04.2014 - Regarding payment of ex-gratia compensation to family of polling personnel who die or sustain injuries while on election duty

2. In case of death of any officer who is on election duty a sum of **Rs. 10 lakh** compensation shall be given to the nearest relative of the deceased.

3. In case of death due to any incident of crime, terrorist attack or natural calamity, bomb attack, weapon attack, anti-social activity, a sum of **Rs. 20 lakh** compensation shall be provided to the nearest kin.
4. In case of loss of limbs, loss of vision or any permanent disability a minimum sum of **Rs. 5 lakh** compensation shall be provided (as explained above in case such incidents occur due to terrorist attack or anti-social elements the compensation amount shall be doubled).
5. Along with this, the State Govt. employees shall also receive DCRG retirement fund, KGID, group insurance (GIS) and all other eligible facilities as per KSCR Rules.

6. Health Monitoring

**6.a. From Health Department: Circular no: HFW 75ACS 2018 Dated: 05-05-2018 regarding Health arrangements for polling personnel and cashless treatment
Circular no: HFW75/ACS/2018 Dated-23.4.2018- regarding Healthcare for polling personnel including security personnel during the period of election for Karnataka Legislative Assembly 2018**

Services of a team of doctors shall be provided to meet any cases of medical emergency. The staff on election duty will be able to easily access medical assistance in case of emergency. The staff on election duty shall be provided necessary health facility not only on the day of attending duty but also on the returning day at the dispatch centres. The District Health Officers shall be designated as nodal officers to monitor this.

Points that need to be given special importance

6.b. Health Safety team shall be appointed at the pre-election training centre. Arrangements like medical help and emergency medical kits shall be made at the District and Taluk Health Centres. Contact details of the nearest specialty hospital and the nearest route shall be kept handy in case of any emergency.

6.c. Proper medical facilities shall also be maintained at the Election Staff dispatch centres.

6. d. The election staff may require medical help on the day of election. Hence, the Health Nodal Officer shall keep all the details like the address and phone numbers of the nearest PHC, CHC, Taluk Health Centre and District Health Centres handy. The doctors and health assistants shall be compulsorily present at the Health Centres on the day of elections and the day before. The District Health Officer shall conduct a Taluk Health Officers meeting and ensure that all required medical help and services are available on those days, along with ambulances that shall respond within 30 minutes of any emergency calls. The District Health Officers and other related officers shall conduct a meeting regarding this.

7. Honorarium shall be provided to the election staff through cashless, deposited to their bank accounts in advance.

8. Necessary facilities shall be provided for the women and differently abled election staff on duty.

9. A help desk shall be opened in advance to provide guidance to the election staff.

Welfare measures for Security personnel, Central Armed Reserved Forces

All necessary facilities has been ensured to the Armed Reserve Forces and security personnel who are on election duty. Facilities like ration, gas cylinder, drinking water, health facility, toilet facility, etc., is being ensured. As the elections are held during summer it is ensured that the centres have fan or coolers. An officer from the Revenue Department has been nominated to overlook the requirements of the armed forces personnel. The District Election Officer and the District Superintendent of Police shall take out time and visit the place where the armed reserve forces personnel are put up and discuss with them and instil confidence. Extra concern shall be taken to monitor the requirements of the CRPF personnel and ensure all necessary measures to conduct smooth voting by discussing with them.

CHUNAVANA ANDROID APP AND ELECTION INFORMATION DASHBOARD

The Chunavana Android App is developed by the CEO of Karnataka after assessing the need of the public through a specialized KAP Survey is available for the public download now in the Google Play Store. The survey report revealed that out of the people who did not vote 25% was because they were not aware of their polling stations, 17.5 % of the urban voters did not vote because of long queue and avoided standing in the queue and 7.5 % of the urban voters did not vote because they are unaware of their candidates and the constituencies. The Chunavana Android App will ease the difficulty of finding the citizens' polling station and assembly constituency by just a click of the button. The citizen can navigate to the polling station with ease and avoid traffic on the day of poll and reach the polling station. The citizens can now see the candidates contesting in their constituency and their details to get an introduction about who is going to serve them for the next five years.

The population details, elector details, trends in previous elections, candidates, winning margins and comparisons were provided for the citizen to understand the democracy in play.
