The Election Commission of India has decided to hold Bye-Election to fill vacancies in the Karnataka Legislative Assembly as per the following schedule:

7	Date before which election shall be completed	15.04.2017 (SATURDAY)


2. Electoral Rolls which have been published in 10-01-2017 will be used for these Bye-elections.

3. Poll will be conducted at all the Polling Stations using Electronic Voting Machine (EVMs).

4. As per the instructions of the Commission, voting have been allowed only after proper identification of electors. Identifications shall be done on the basis of Electoral Photo Identity Cards (EPIC) or Photo Voter Slips or alternative identity documents permitted by the Commission.

5. Model Code of Conduct enumerated in Commission's letter No. 437/6/INST/2012/CC&BE, dated: 26-04-2012, for the guidance of the political parties and candidates have come into force with immediate effect i.e., from 09-03-2017, the date on which the Election Commission of India has released the Press Note about holding of Bye-Election to the said Assembly Constituencies.
