1. Model Code of Conduct, Election Expenditure and Law & Order enforcement:

Based on the information gathered from the enforcement agencies the following information on violations under Model Code of Conduct, Election Expenditure and Law & Order enforcement is provided from 29.03.2023.

The total seizure till this date from the date of announcement of the elections to the Karnataka General Legislative Assembly Elections 2023 has crossed Rs. 200 crore.

b. Cases booked:

- > Flying Squads, SSTs and Police authorities have booked **1,629** FIR's with regard to seizures of cash, liquor, drugs, precious metal and Freebies.
- > 69,281 arms have been got deposited, 18 arms were impounded, 20 arms license have been cancelled, 4,361 cases are booked under preventive sections of CrPC, out of which 6,660 persons were bounded over. 11,276 Non-bailable warrants were executed from the date of announcement of elections.
- Excise Department has booked **2,082** Heinous Cases, **1,601** cases for Breach of Licence Conditions, **73** NDPS and **11,389** cases under Section 15 (a) of Karnataka Excise act 1965. And also **1,412** different types of Vehicles have been seized.

c. Special Report:

- FST team has seized cash **Rs. 60,50,000** in Gangavathi Constituency, Koppal district.
- SST team has seized 7.793 Kgs of Gold worth Rs. 50,42,736 in Dharwad Constituency, Dharawad district.
- SST team has seized 11.42 Kgs of Gold worth Rs. 6,49,17,519 in Haveri Constituency, Haveri district.
- SST team has seized **74.896** Kgs of Silver worth Rs. **44,63,973** in Haveri Constituency, Haveri district.

2. Public Grievance Redressal:

Out of the **10,013** calls received through Voter Helplines, **9,844** people have sought information, **26** have given feedback, 25 have made suggestions and 118 have registered complaints. All 10,013 calls have been disposed off. In addition, 5,957complaints have been registered by the citizens on NGRS portal, out of which, 5,647 complaints have been disposed off.

3. cVIGIL:

4,060 Complaints have been received through cVIGIL application. Major complaints received are related to Posters/Banners without permission (2293), Money Distribution (58), Posters without mandatory declaration(152), Display of Firearms, Intimidation (51), Distribution of gifts/coupons (55), Distribution of Liquor (33), property defacement (243), vehicle or convoy without permission (72), out of which 3392Complaints are found to be correct and action has been taken

4. Media:

The complaints have been received through emails (232) and letters (293), Newspapers (80), TV Channels (38), Social media (59). Out of the total 702 Complaints 478 have been disposed off.

5. SUVIDHA:

Under SUVIDHA 7,498 Applications for permissions have been received; out of which 5,545 have been accepted and 1,327 have been rejected. 88 are in progress, 363 are pending and 175 are cancelled.
