## 1. Home voting of Absentee voters:

$\mathbf{7 7 , 2 2 7}$ in the age group of $80+$ and PwD voters out of $\mathbf{9 9 , 5 2 9}$ voters opted for home voting have cast their votes at their homes on 30.04.2023.
Today 125 Teams are covering 125 routes and undertaking home voting of 11,461 in the age group of 80+ and PwD voters.

## a. Cases booked:

> Flying Squads, SSTs and Police authorities have booked 2514 FIR's with regard to seizures of cash, liquor, drugs, precious metal and Freebies.
> 69847 arms have been got deposited, 18 arms were impounded, 20 arms license have been cancelled, 5583 cases are booked under preventive sections of CrPC, out of which 10297 persons were bounded over. 15944 Non-bailable warrants were executed from the date of announcement of elections.
> Excise Department has booked 3247 Heinous Cases, 3004 cases for Breach of Licence Conditions, 94 NDPS and 30132 cases under Section 15 (a) of Karnataka Excise act 1965. And also 2241 different types of Vehicles have been seized.
b. Special Report:
$>$ FST team has seized $\mathbf{7 . 8 8 1} \mathbf{K G}$ of Gold worth Rs.3,94,37,971, $3.993 \mathbf{~ K g}$ Raw Gold worth Rs.2,22,04,881, 0.735 Gram Diamond Studded Gold worth Rs. 41,27,537, 0.6538 Gram Diamond Ornaments worth Rs. $\mathbf{6 , 4 8 , 2 3 6}$ and $\mathbf{1 0 . 8 8 7} \mathrm{Kg}$ Raw Silver worth Rs. 6,39,128 in Molakalmuru Constituency of Chitradurga District
$>$ FST team has seized Cash of Rs. 89,01,600 in Kundapura Constituency of Udupi District
$>$ SST team has seized cash of Rs.70, 00,000 in Terdal Constituency of Bagalkote District.
$>$ SST team has seized cash of Rs.31,88,076 in Turuvekere Constituency of Tumkur District.

## 3. Public Grievance Redressal:

Out of the 29,111 calls received through Voter Helplines, 26,223 people have sought information, 65 have given feedback, 39 have made suggestions and 2,784 have registered complaints. All 29,111 calls have been disposed off. In addition, 10,054 complaints have been registered by the citizens on NGRS portal, out of which, $\mathbf{9 , 8 3 3}$ complaints have been disposed off.
4. cVIGIL:

13,897 Complaints have been received through cVIGIL application. Major complaints received are related to Posters/Banners without permission $(\mathbf{8}, \mathbf{0 5 2})$, Money Distribution (134), Posters without mandatory declaration (230), Display of Firearms, Intimidation (84), Distribution of gifts/coupons (157), Distribution of Liquor (111), property defacement (431), vehicle or convoy without permission (218), out of which 12,495 Complaints are found to be correct and action has been taken.

## 5. Media:

The complaints have been received through emails (422) and letters (705), Newspapers (153), TV Channels (65), Social Media (101). Out of the total 1,446 Complaints $\mathbf{1 , 1 9 2}$ have been disposed off.
6. SUVIDHA:

Under SUVIDHA 21,515 Applications for permissions have been received; out of which $\mathbf{1 8 , 5 3 7}$ have been accepted and 2,034 have been rejected. 102 are in progress, 444 are pending and 398 are cancelled.
