PRESS RELEASE

1. Home voting of Absentee voters:

70,540 (87.90%) voters in the age group of 80+ out of **80,250** voters opted for home voting have cast their vote at their homes. Similarly **16,961 (87.98%)** PwD voters out of **19,279** voters have cast their votes up to 03.05.2023. In total **87,501 (87.92%)** voters have cast their votes out of **99,529** voters opted.

2. Model Code of Conduct, Election Expenditure and Law & Order enforcement: Based on the information gathered from the enforcement agencies the following information on violations under Model Code of Conduct, Election Expenditure and Law & Order enforcement is provided from 29.03.2023.

a. Cases booked:

- ➢ Flying Squads, SSTs and Police authorities have booked 2602 FIR's with regard to seizures of cash, liquor, drugs, precious metal and Freebies.
- 69854 arms have been got deposited, 18 arms were impounded, 20 arms license have been cancelled, 5633 cases are booked under preventive sections of CrPC, out of which 10697 persons were bounded over. 16395 Non-bailable warrants were executed from the date of announcement of elections.
- Excise Department has booked 3306 Heinous Cases, 3086 cases for Breach of Licence Conditions, 99 NDPS and 31183 cases under Section 15 (a) of Karnataka Excise act 1965. And also 2290 different types of Vehicles have been seized.

b. Special Report:

- FST team has seized 80 KG of Ganja worth Rs. 40,00,000 in Pulakeshinagar Constituency of Bangalore City East District
- SST team has seized 5.548 KG of Jewells and Gold Worth Rs. 2,76,15,021 in Tarikere Constituency of Chikkamagaluru District.

3. Public Grievance Redressal:

Out of the **30,240** calls received through Voter Helplines, **27,327** people have sought information, **65** have given feedback, **43** have made suggestions and **2,805** have registered complaints. All **30,240** calls have been disposed off. In addition, **10,463** complaints have been registered by the citizens on NGRS portal, out of which, **10,214** complaints have been disposed off.

4. cVIGIL:

14,862 Complaints have been received through cVIGIL application. Major complaints received are related to Posters/Banners without permission **(8,738)**, Money Distribution **(150)**, Posters without mandatory declaration **(237)**, Display of Firearms, Intimidation **(86)**, Distribution of gifts/coupons **(173)**, Distribution of Liquor **(119)**, property defacement **(432)**, vehicle or convoy without permission **(243)**, out of which **13,356** Complaints are found to be correct and action has been taken.

5. Media:

The complaints have been received through emails (425) and letters (726), Newspapers (153), TV Channels (68), Social Media (107). Out of the total 1,494 Complaints 1,225 have been disposed off.

6. SUVIDHA:

Under SUVIDHA **22,550** Applications for permissions have been received; out of which **19,573** have been accepted and **2,065** have been rejected. **94** are in progress, **409** are pending and **409** are cancelled.
