

#### 4. Cases Booked:

- a) Flying Squads, SSTs and Police authorities have booked **1,587** FIRs with regard to seizures of cash, liquor, drugs, precious metal and Freebies.
- b) Excise Department has booked **2,002** Heinous Cases, **2,531** cases for Breach of Licence Conditions, **119** NDPS and **12,766** cases under Section 15 (a) of Karnataka Excise act 1965 and also **1,214** different types of Vehicles have been seized.

## 5. Special Reports:

- c) Chamarajanagar, Kollegala Rural Police Station Team has seized 2.170 Kg Gold value Rs.1,02,90,469 in Kollegala, Chamarajnagar Parliamentary Constituency, Chamarajnagar Dist.
- d) SST Team has seized **20.874 Gold** value **Rs. 12,50,45,115** in Lokekere Checkpost, Davangere Parliamentary Constituency, Davangere Dist.

#### 6. Public Grievance Redressal:

Out of the **16,999** calls received through Voter Helpline, **16,830** people have sought information, **20** have given feedback, **19** have made suggestions and **130** have registered complaints. Cumulatively **16,999** calls have been disposed off. In addition, **10,548** complaints have been registered by the citizens on NGRS portal, out of which, **10,379** complaints have been disposed off.

#### 7. cVIGIL:

**21,506** Complaints have been received through cVIGIL application. Major complaints received are related to Posters/Banners without permission **13,024**, Posters without mandatory declaration **1,001**, property defacement **298**, Money Distribution **174**, Distribution of gifts/coupons **99**, Campaigning during ban period **44**, Distribution of Liquor **124**, Vehicle or convoy without permission **63**, Religious or communal speeches/messages **44**, Display of Firearms, Intimidation **23**. Out of which **20,276** Complaints are found to be correct and action has been taken.

### 8. Media:

The complaints have been received through emails **178**, and letters **517**, Newspapers **24**, TV Channels **30** and Social Media **49** Out of the total **776** Complaints, **77** have been disposed off.

#### 9. ENCORE:

Under ENCORE, **4,009** Applications for permissions have been received; out of which **2,948** have been accepted and **594** have been rejected. **43** are in progress, **278** are pending and **146** are cancelled.

#### 10. Postal Ballot:

The Election Commission of India has provided an opportunity for the above 85 years (AVSC) electors and the differently abled (PwD) (AVPD) electors to cast their vote through postal voting.

Accordingly, the voting for the electors above 85 years of age (AVSC) and disabled (PwD) (AVPD) who have opted for Home Voting facility in the 2nd phase of the Lok Sabha Elections-2024 is scheduled on the following dates:

Electors who are above 85 years of age (AVSC) and PwD electors (AVPD) are eligible to vote through Home Voting only.								

All the Political Parties have been informed to appoint an official representative on behalf of the contested candidates to observe the voting processes of the above Home Voting in the 2<sup>nd</sup> phase of Lok Sabha Elections-2024.
